### Definitions and inclusion criteria for select indicators

**Low Birth Weight:** <2,500g at delivery (5.5 lbs); **Very Low Birth Weight:** <1,500g at delivery (3.3 lbs); **Preterm Birth:** <37 weeks gestational age; **Very Preterm Birth:** <32 weeks gestational age. **Fetal Death:** stillborn with gestation ≥ 20 weeks or birth weight > 350 grams; **Perinatal Death:** fetal deaths plus deaths to infants under 7 days of age. **Neonatal Death:** deaths to infants under 28 days of age; **Post Neonatal Death:** deaths to infants that occur between 28 days and 365 days after birth; **Infant Death:** deaths to infants under 1 year of age
