RE: RECERTIFICATION AND EDUCATION

During the transition phase from the traditional recertification model to the NCCP model, the National Registry of EMTs and the Louisiana Bureau of EMS recognize that managing the education profile in NREMT may not reflect precisely the content and hours covered. For those nationally certified EMS professionals expiring on March 31, 2016 and March 31, 2017 either the DOT refresher or the 'new' national refresher (NCCR) will satisfy the national requirements and be accepted for recertification.

If you choose to recertify using the DOT curriculum, this chart describes the difference in hours that can be applied to the Local (LCCR) or Individual (ICCR) requirements when managing your education in your NREMT profile.

CERTIFICATION LEVEL	DOT HOURS	NCCP HOURS	Difference to be applied in LCCR or ICCR
EMT	24	20	4
AEMT	36	25	11
PARAMEDIC	48	30	18

Those individuals who expire March 31, 2018 are required to meet the NCCP content to recertify.
