AMOUNT, DURATION, AND SCOPE OF MEDICAL AND REMEDIAL CARE AND SERVICES PROVIDED LIMITATIONS ON THE AMOUNT, DURATION, AND SCOPE OF CERTAIN ITEMS OF PROVIDED MEDICAL AND REMEDICAL CARE AND SERVICES DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Unlicensed Professionals

Unlicensed Professionals rendering Crisis Stabilization services must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be at least twenty-four (24) years old; and
- 2. Possess a minimum of bachelor's degree (preferred) OR an associate's degree and two (2) years of work experience in the human services field.

Credentialed Peer Support Specialist (CPSS)

A CPSS must meet the staff qualifications as outlined in the Peer Support Service section. CPSS must receive regularly scheduled clinical supervision from a <u>Peer</u> <u>Supervisor. The Peer Supervisor must be either a</u> Licensed Mental Health Professional (LMHP) or be supervised by an LMHP. <u>LMHP sPeer Supervisors must have the practice-specific education, experience, training, and credentials, and licensure to coordinate an array of behavioral health services, and shall complete the required OBH-approved Peer <u>Supervisor Training</u>.</u>
