Highlights and News

- The CSoC Director presented a brief overview of CSoC for the Louisiana Council
 of Juvenile and Family Court Judges for their January meeting.
- In January, OBH, Magellan, and NCFS staff successfully presented a brief overview of CSoC for Families Helping Families New Orleans with over 100 participants in attendance.
- The CSoC Director met with and presented a brief overview of CSoC to Dr. Dunham, Dr. Mamon and other staff at Metropolitan Human Services District.
- The OBH CSoC team was invited and will be presenting at the 42nd Annual Governor's Conference on Juvenile Justice in March 2023. The topic will be "The Story of Strengths Based Planning: Sharing CSoC Impacts and Outcomes."
- The CSoC Director and Magellan State Agency Liaison have been invited to present about CSoC to OCDD staff at their staff meeting on March 15, 2023.




Highlights and News

- Humana went live as the sixth Healthy Louisiana MCO in January 2023.
- The Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) changes to CSoC disenrollment criteria remain in place, however Medicaid and OBH are working with Magellan to establish steps that will need to be taken to begin the unwind to the National Public Health Emergency.
- Magellan continues to take direct referrals to CSoC and the results continue to make a positive impact on the program.






CSoC Children Inpatient Psychiatric Utilization






Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Outcomes: Clinical Functioning






CANS Outcomes: Reduction in Prevalence of Actionable Needs (2021)






CANS Outcomes: Improvements in Strength Items (2021)

CANS: School Functioning








Living Situation at Discharge
