






# Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Outcomes: Clinical Functioning






# CANS Outcomes: Reduction in Prevalence of Actionable Needs (2022)


#### CANS Outcomes: Improvements in Strength Items (2022)


# CANS Outcomes: Top 10 Needs with Greatest Prevalence Reduction (2022)

### **CANS: School Functioning**






### Parent Support and Training Utilization




### Living Situation at Discharge
