Highlights and News

- Governor Landry issued an updated executive order for continuation of the CSoC Governance Board (JML 24-117).
- Effective July 1, 2024, youth can receive Multi-Systemic Therapy (MST) services while enrolled in CSoC. Magellan held a training for wraparound agency staff about MST.
- Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approved Louisiana's State Plan Amendment (SPA) for the expansion of mental health practitioners to include Provisionally Licensed Professional Counselors (PLPC), Provisionally Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists (PLMFT), and Licensed Master Social Workers (LMSW) effective August 1, 2024.

Highlights and News (Continued)

- The Louisiana Model for Coaching and Training workgroup has been meeting weekly. It consists of representatives from Magellan, OBH, and each wraparound agency.
- Magellan has implemented their new system, Opeeka, and has done multiple training sessions on its various components for wraparound agency staff. They have hosted daily support calls since implementation.
- There is a new version of the Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) assessment and training manual. Magellan incorporated the changes into Opeeka, and trained all of the wraparound agencies.
- The fall coaching leadership summit was held in September in Lafayette. Eckerd Connects did an excellent job preparing for and delivering the summit.

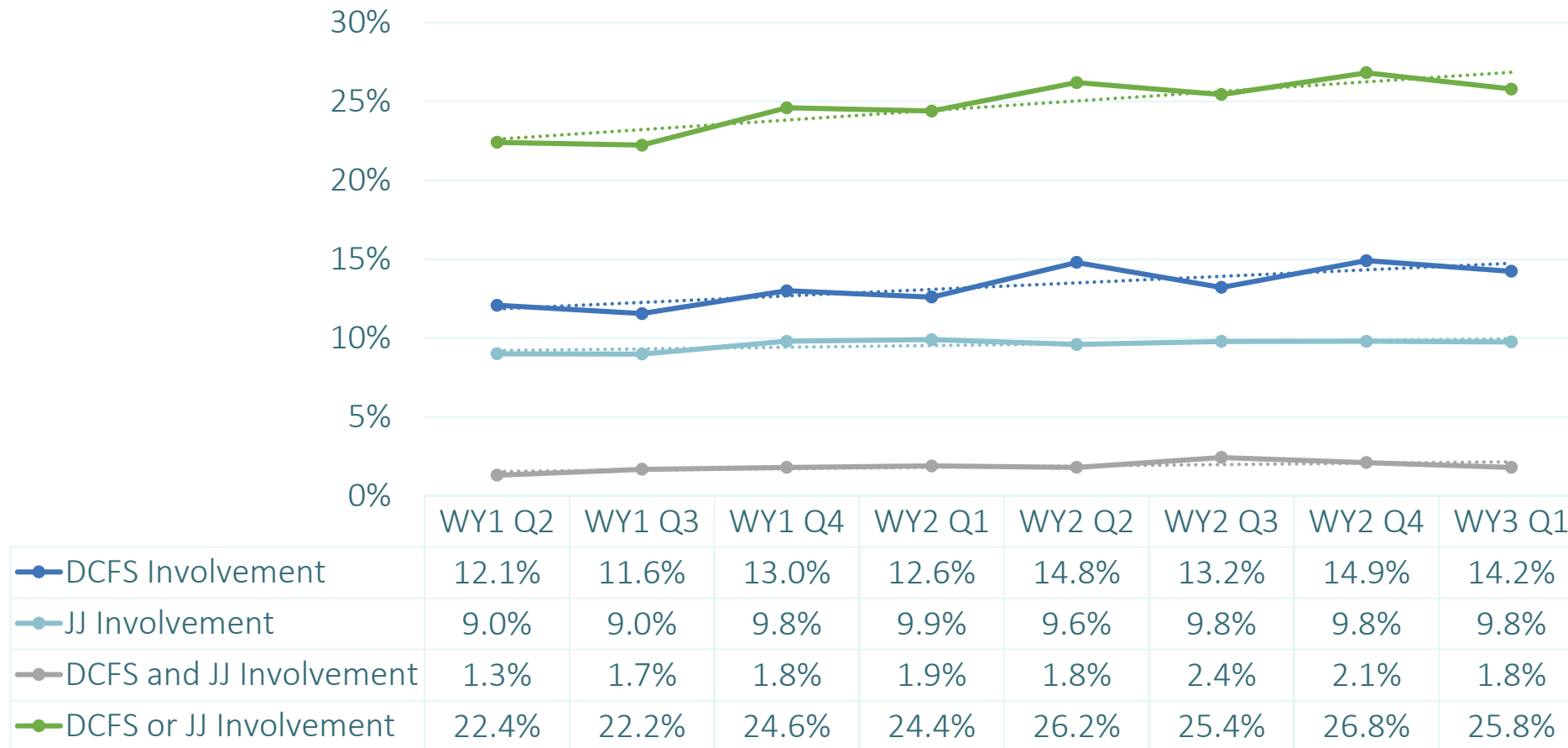

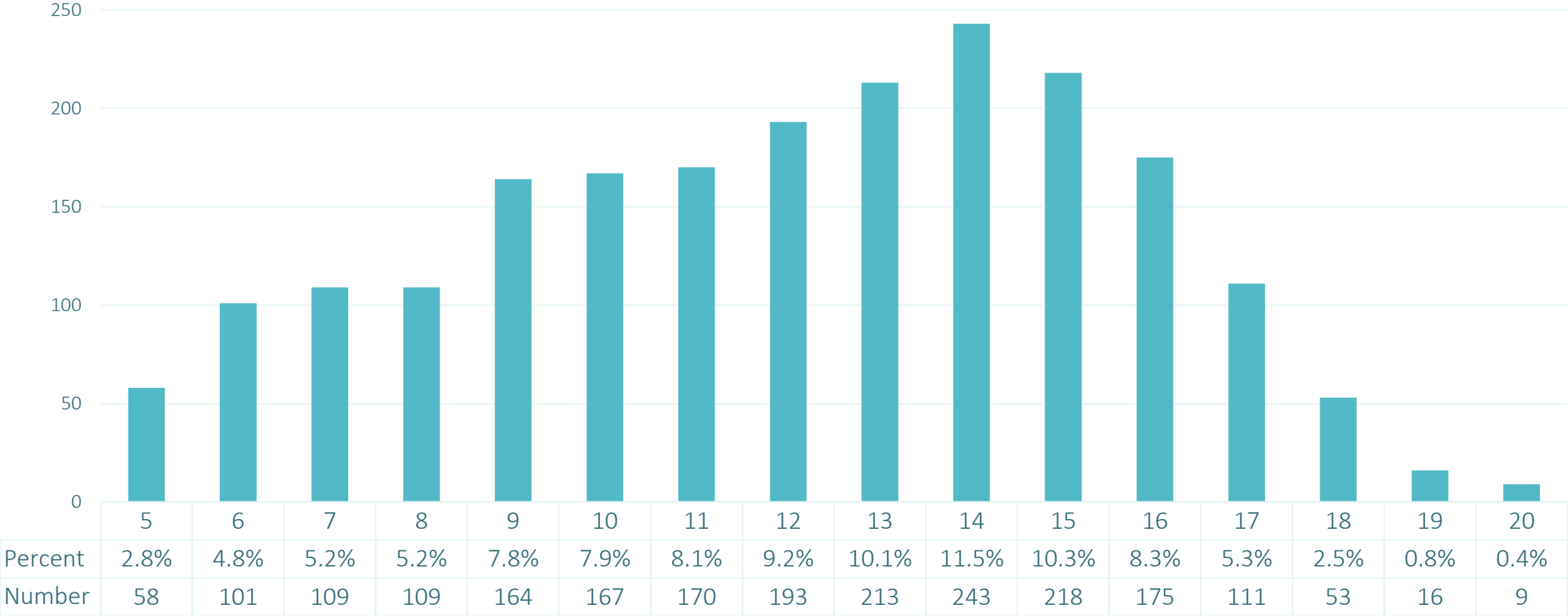

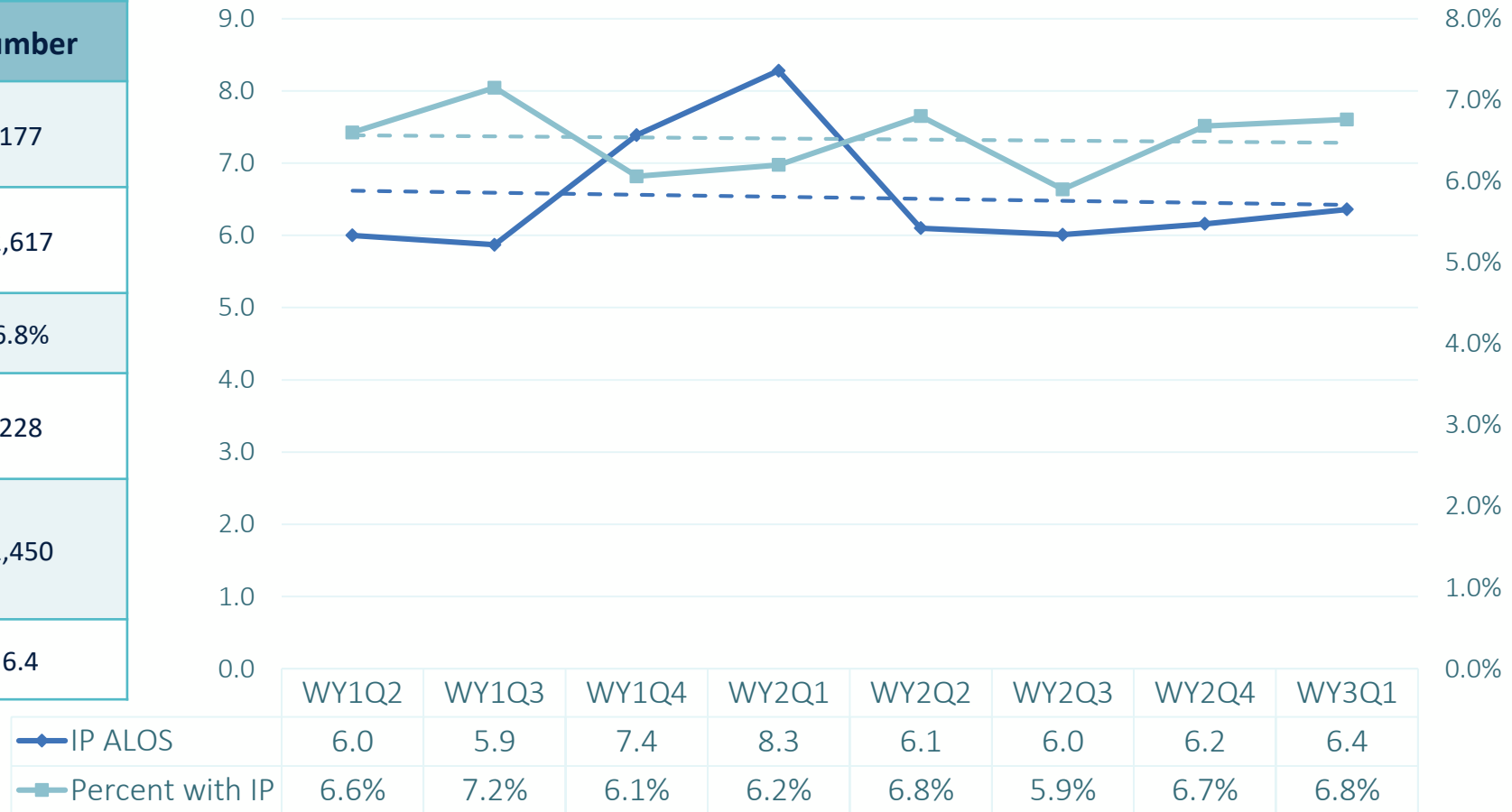

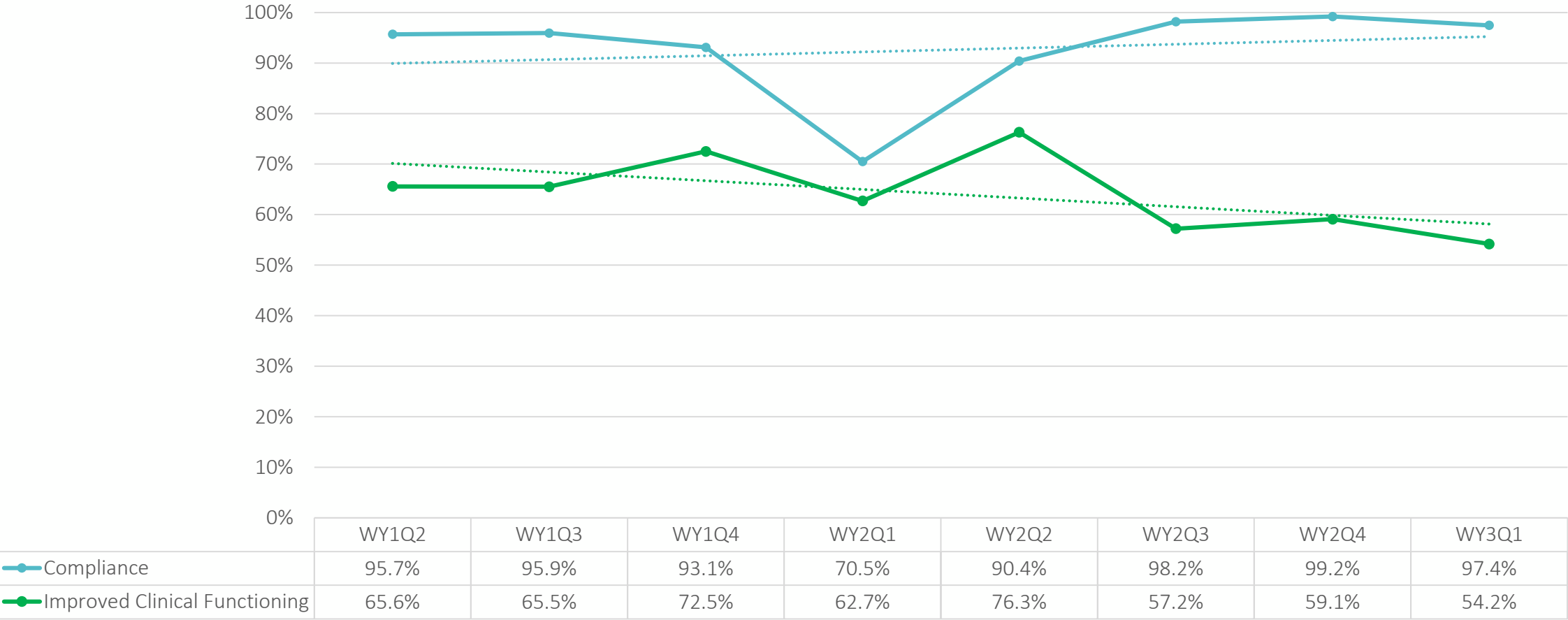

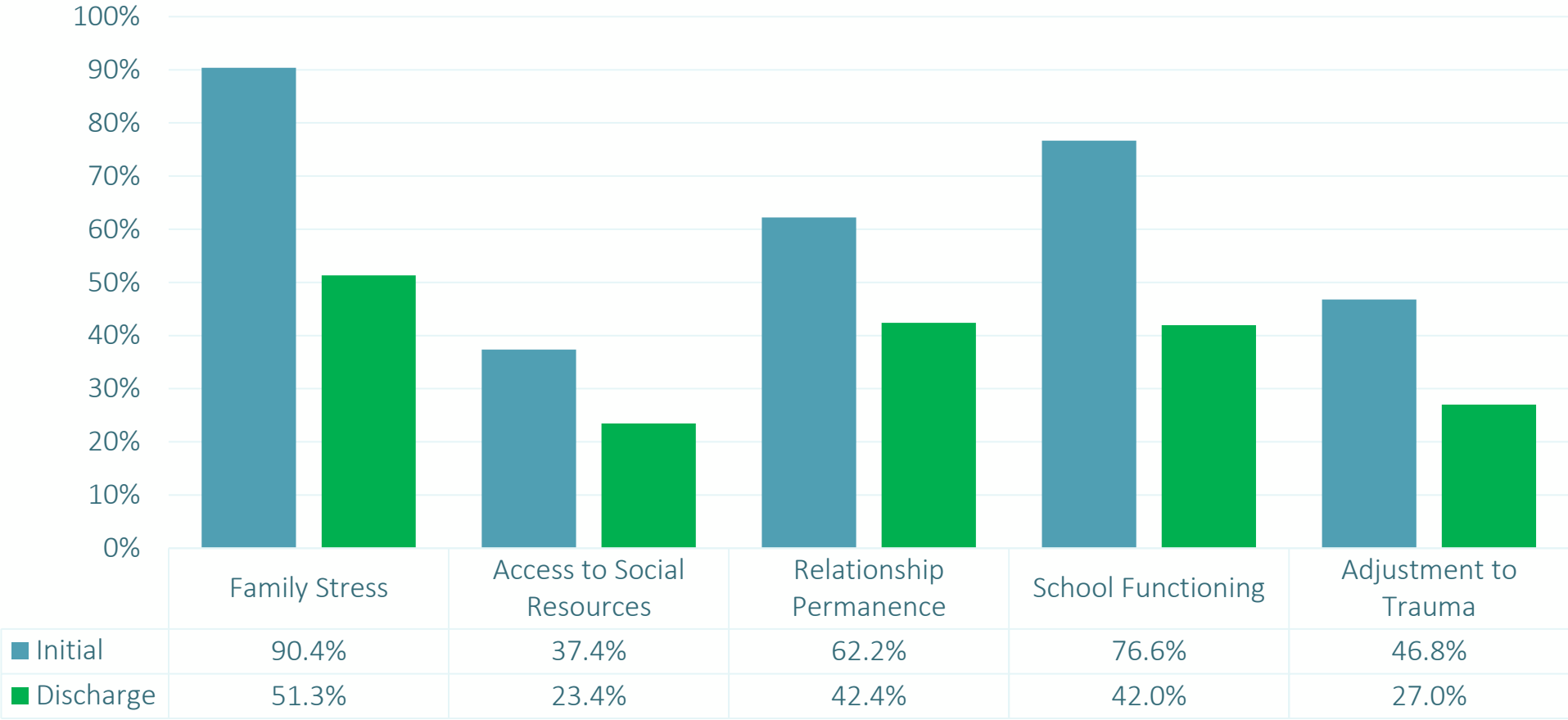

Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Outcomes: Clinical Functioning

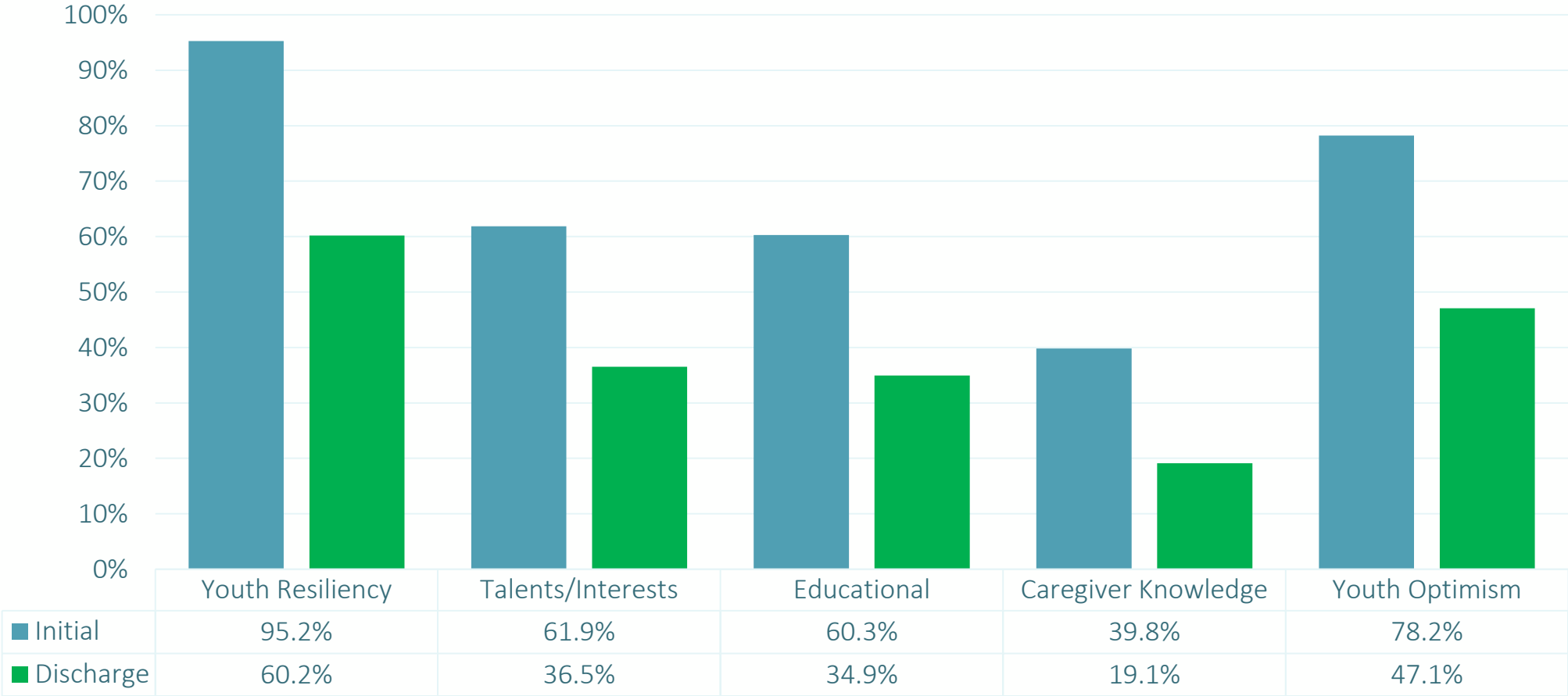


CANS Outcomes: Reduction in Prevalence of Actionable Needs (2023)



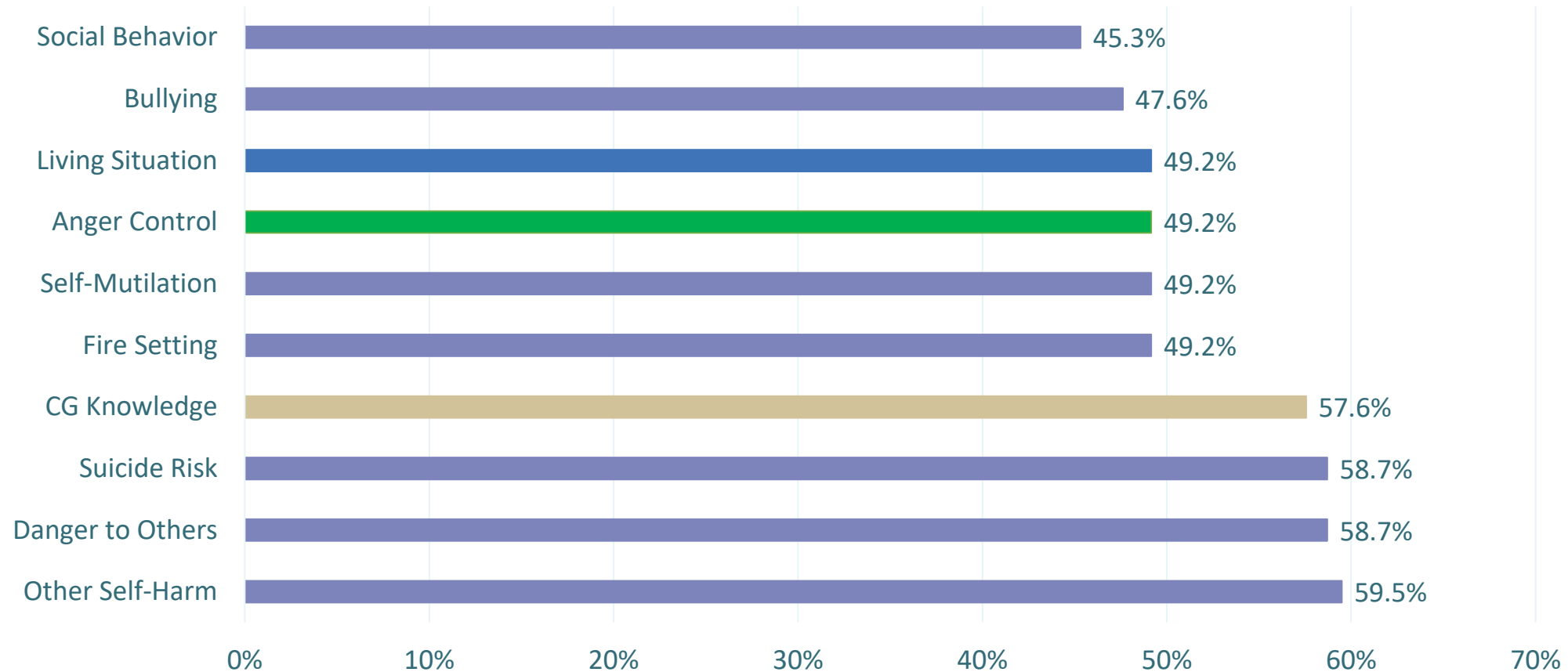

CANS Outcomes: Improvements in Strength Items (2023)



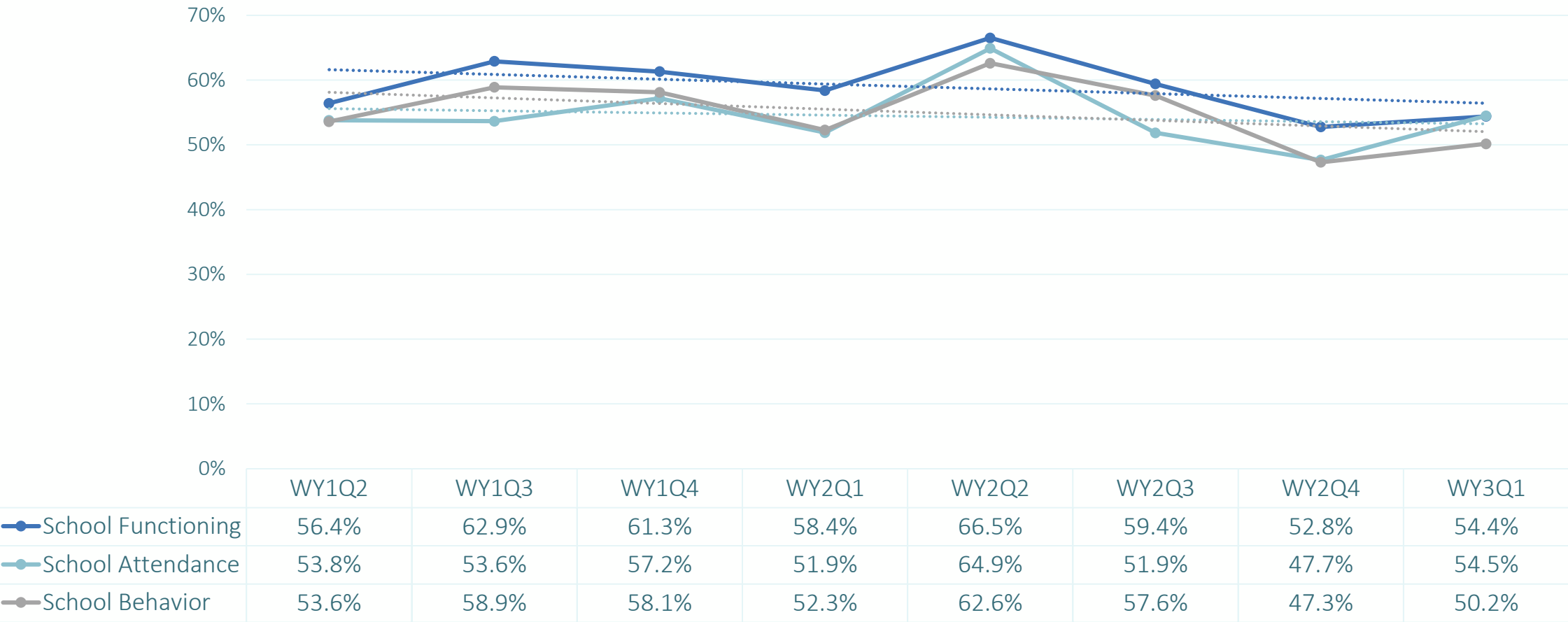

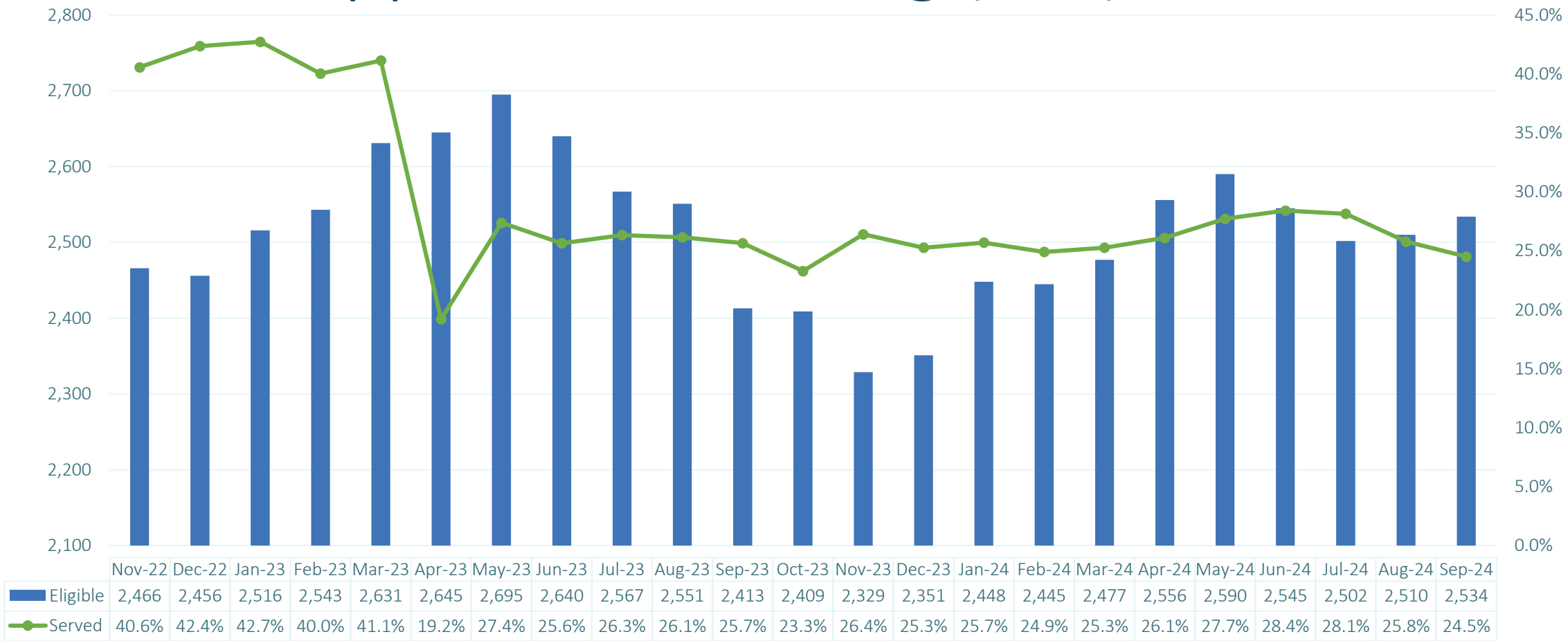

Parent Support and Training (PST) Utilization



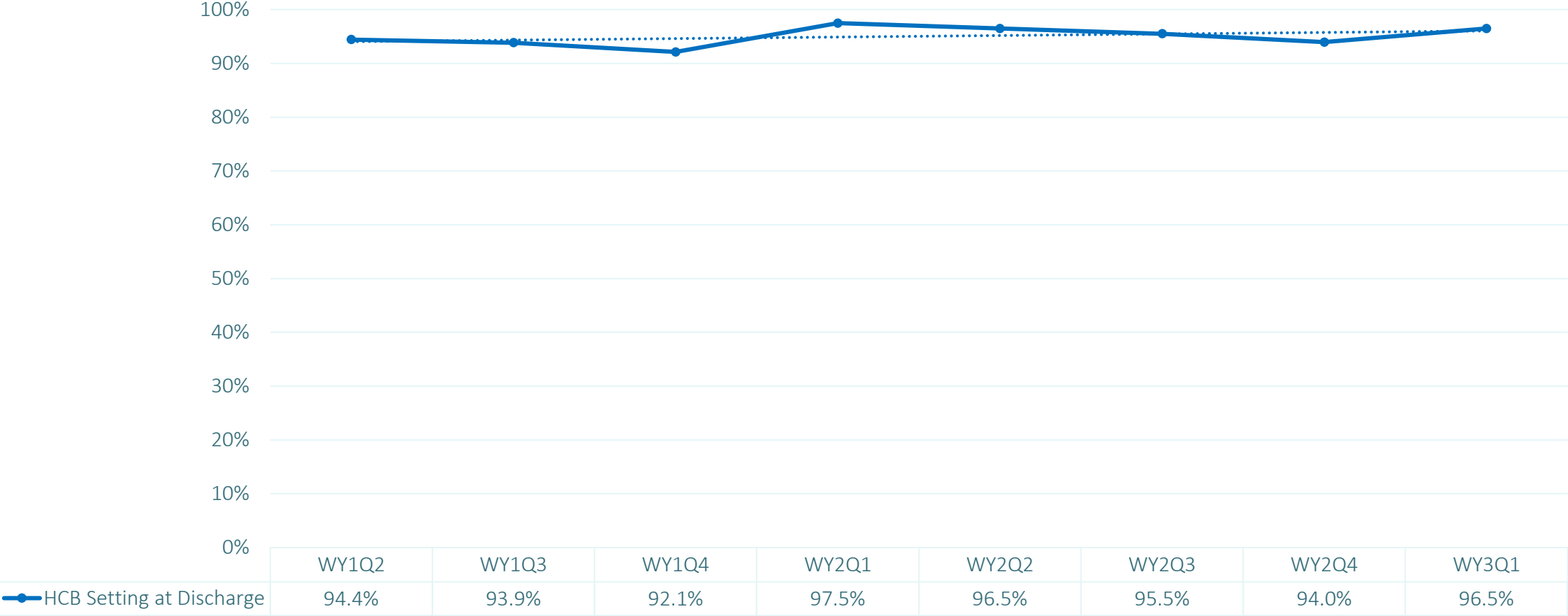

Youth Support and Training (YST) Utilization

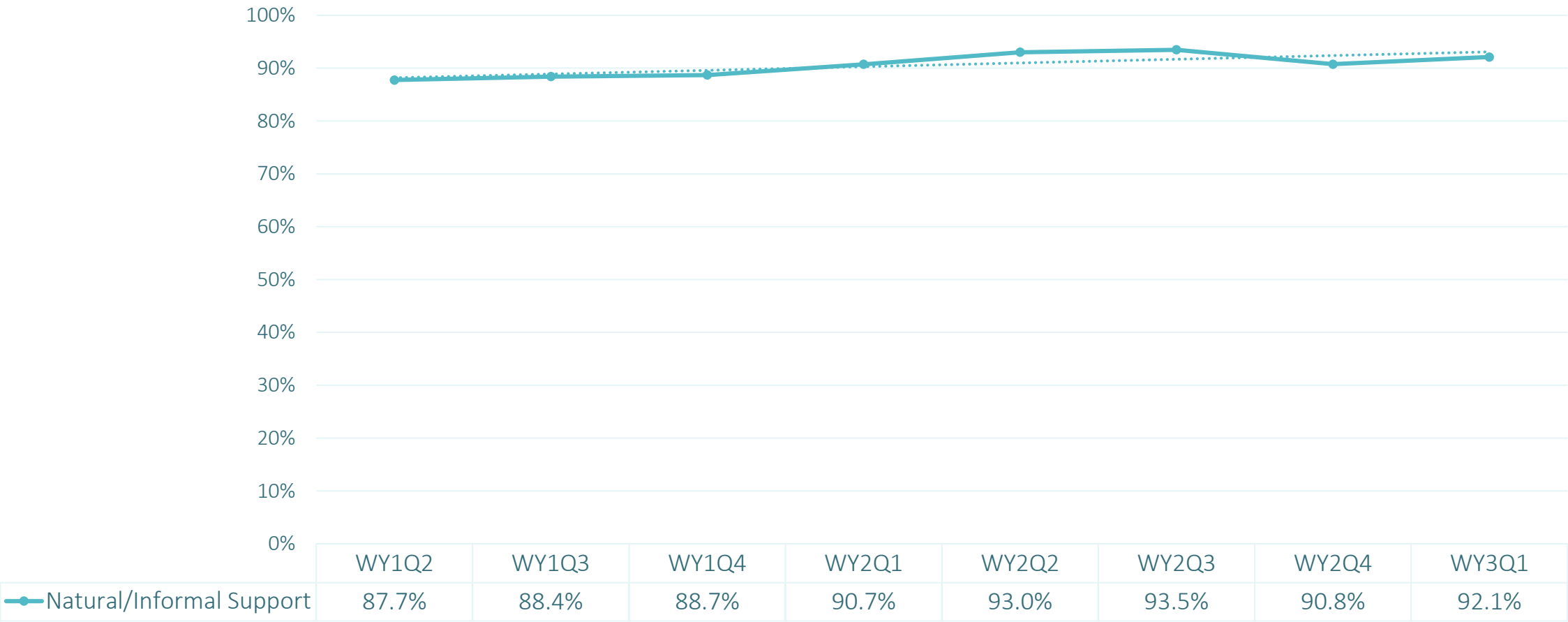
