Highlights and News

- CSoC referrals and enrollment continued to increase this quarter to their highest point yet.
- The Louisiana Model for Coaching and Training was implemented on April 1, 2025.
 - Previously, the state operated under two separate models. All wraparound agencies are now operating under the new model.
 - This was a collaborative effort that included representatives from each wraparound agency, Magellan, and the OBH CSoC team.
 - OBH would like to thank the wraparound agencies and Magellan for the hard work they put into developing and refining training materials for the new model.






Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Outcomes: Clinical Functioning






CANS Outcomes: Reduction in Prevalence of Actionable Needs (2024)






CANS Outcomes: Improvements in Strength Items (2024)





CANS Outcomes: Top 10 Needs with Greatest Prevalence Reduction (2024)



CANS: School Functioning






Parent Support and Training (PST) Utilization


Youth Support and Training (YST) Utilization
