

Louisiana Coordinated System of Care (CSoC) Director's Report to the Governance Board

9/10/2025



Highlights and News

- CSoC enrollment increased this quarter, to the highest point yet.
- LDH, Magellan, Eckerd, and waiver service provider staff collaborated to host a statewide refresher training for Office of Juvenile Justice (OJJ) staff in June. They reviewed CSoC eligibility requirements, the referral process, details about each waiver service, and the role of OJJ staff on the Child and Family Team (CFT).
- The Louisiana Model for Coaching and Training was implemented on April 1,
 2025. Since the previous meeting:
 - OBH began statewide coaching audits under the new model;
 - Magellan has incorporated changes to reflect the new model into their wraparound agency certification process; and
 - Biannual Coaching Summits are being held today in Monroe and next Wednesday as well,
 with Northern and Southern regions traveling to their nearest summit location.










Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Outcomes: Clinical Functioning






CANS Outcomes: Reduction in Prevalence of Actionable Needs (2024)






CANS Outcomes: Improvements in Strength Items (2024)





CANS Outcomes: Top 10 Needs with Greatest Prevalence Reduction (2024)



CANS: School Functioning






Parent Support and Training (PST) Utilization


Youth Support and Training (YST) Utilization




Living Situation at Discharge
