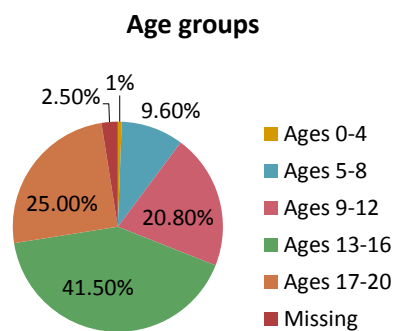

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CSoC: Presenting problem at First Treatment Episode (Self or Other Report)



- 40% = Mood Disorders
- 28% = Other emotional health problems
- 15% = Danger to self
- 8% = Substance use problems
- 8% = Danger to others
- 4% = Family problems
- 2% = Medical/Physical issues

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CSoc: Most frequent FIRST psychiatric diagnosis



- 38% = Deferred
- 27% = Mood Disorders
- 25% = Disruptive Behavior Disorders
- 5% = Pervasive Developmental Disorder/ Mental Retardation
- 3% = Psychosis
- 2% = Substance Use Disorders

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Here is what we know...



- The average age of a CSoC Member is 15.
- Males account for ~ 52% of the CSoC population and females account for ~ 48%.
- The top 5 services requested and authorized for CSoC members are: CSoC Youth/Parent Support and Training, CPST, Homebuilders and Psychosocial Rehab.
- Of the current CSoC enrollment, there have been 95 out of home placements (68 of these were unique members)

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The Future.....



- Detailed analyses of provider network by region
- CSoC Quality Measure Tracking tools will reflect:
 - outcome measure analysis based on 17 Quality Indicators
 - a more detailed profile of members enrolled
- As the data set matures, the outcomes can guide future plans for expanding the CSoC program into other regions.
