Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Hebert-Magee.

Welcome and Roll Call

Dr. Shantel Hebert-Magee welcomed members

Roll call was conducted by Kate Stewart, confirming that a quorum was not present.

Medicaid Program Updates

LDH Medicaid Deputy Director of Quality Improvement, Population Health and Health Equity, Pharmacy and Program Operations provided Medicaid program updates:

- Recent Leadership changes for LDH.
 - o Dr. Ralph Abraham is now our Surgeon General
 - Michael Harrington is our Secretary
 - o Dr. Pete Croughan remains our Deputy Secretary
 - And Drew Maranto is the Undersecretary
- Our Medicaid Director reports directly to the Secretary.
- Jackie Cummings is the new contact for Third Party Liability

• RFPs

- Began the process of drafting a new request for proposals (RFP) for our Managed Care Companies. Our goal is to begin new MCO contracts effective July 1, 2026.
- Also, drafting a new RFP for Dental Benefits Managers. The goal to go live for new dental contracts is January 2026.
- o Lastly, a third RFP in progress is the Supplemental rebate RFP.

TMaH Model

- Medicaid is working with the Office of Public Health and the Office of Women's Health and Community Health to complete the application for the CMS Transforming Maternal Health (TMaH) Model.
- If Louisiana is selected as a participant, then this would allow the state to use federal grant funding to review and implement improvements to maternal health care for our residents.

• Cell and Gene Therapy

- Medicaid has submitted a letter of intent to CMS to participate in the Cell and Gene Therapy (CGT) Access Model.
- This model aims to improve health outcomes for people with Medicaid living with rare and severe diseases by increasing their access to potentially transformative treatments.

Pharmacy PDL

- Effective July 1, there was a change to our Medicaid Pharmacy Preferred Drug List.
- The previous PDL indicated a preference of some brand name drugs over generic drugs.
- The revised PDL gives preferred status to both brand and generic versions of these drugs.
- With the implementation of the new PDL, prescribing providers must note "brand name necessary" on any prescription where they want to ensure pharmacies fill their prescriptions with a brand name drug. If this notation is absent, individual pharmacists will make the decision on whether to fill the prescription with brand or generic drugs.

CMS Rules

- We are in the process of implementing new CMS rules.
 - Will phase-in to reach 25% of the BAC MAC to serve as the HCBS advisory committee

- There is the Managed Care Final Rule
- And the Access to Medicaid Services Final Rule

Medicaid Medical Director Updates

- Did not review nor approve May 14, 2024 meeting minutes or review "revised by-laws" (no quorum)
- HR246 Representative Mandie Landry State Legislation to create a
 Community- Based Social Services Committee request the LDH through
 MAC to study ways for Medicaid to invest in community-based social service
 organization (CBO) that address health-related social needs (HRSN) and
 social determinants of health (SDOH).
 - To add an additional subcommittee would require a subcommittee chair who would be responsible for recruiting subcommittee members and SMEs to research and evaluate the different 1115 waivers
 - New subcommittee to evaluate whole person health and focus on nonclinical health factors – Nick Albares – Chair
