

Have you heard about Assistive Technology?



Your Office of Aging and Adult Services (OAAS) support coordinator will review your unique situation to see if Assistive Technology will help you.

Meet Jack, he is 85 years old and enjoys attending the Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) center 3 days every week through the ADHC Waiver program. He is a widow and lives alone. His children and grandchildren live out of state and they don't get to come see him very often. Jack's children always had a computer in the home for schoolwork. When they grew up, he played word games on the computer to help keep his brain sharp, reviewed his online medical charts, read online books, etc. Last year, the computer broke, he hasn't had the money to buy another one and stopped paying for his internet service.

With the new Assistive Technology service, Jack can get an electronic tablet, a screen protector and a case once he gets his internet services back on. Jack's Support Coordinator (SC) will give him the information on some low-cost internet options and talk to him about whether he would need help setting up his tablet. Once he has internet, the SC will purchase the tablet, screen protector and case. The SC will bring the items to him at home. At this visit, if there is no one else to help him, the SC will unbox the tablet, turn it on, connect it to the internet and show Mr. Jack how to charge it. Since he already has an email address and uses his doctor's office online charts, the SC will just make sure that he can still access these files and his email account. His email account makes it easier for his SC to get in touch with him to schedule visits. It also keeps him in touch with his kids and grandkids. The online medical charts makes it easy for Jack to ask for medication refills without having to call the doctor. He can also read the notes from the doctor visits, which helps him tell his SC what is going on with his health. Thanks to this new service, Jack will be able to connect with technology again which will make him so happy!
