



Is someone you know ready to transition back home or into the community?

My Place Louisiana, or Money Follows the Person (MFP), helps people move from an institution back into community-based or home living settings.

We serve children and adults with developmental disabilities!

- Children (birth until their 19th birthday) residing in hospitals, rehabilitation hospitals, or nursing facilities
- People with a DD of any age residing in nursing facilities, ICFs/DD, or specialty hospital(s)

Ready? Check your eligibility!

To be eligible, a person must:

- Currently reside in a qualified institution for 60 consecutive days, such as a:
 - Nursing Facility
 - Intermediate Care Facility (ICFs) for people with developmental disabilities
 - Rehabilitation Hospital
- Qualify for an OCDD waiver
- Meet Medicaid financial eligibility requirements
- Qualify for level of care eligibility for home and community-based services in the My Place program
