

OCDD ROADSHOWS

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services declared a Public Health Emergency (PHE) for COVID-19 on January 31, 2020. In March 2020, the Office for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities (OCDD) requested and received certain program exceptions to help keep families and participants safe. These exceptions are scheduled to last until six month after May 11, 2023, which is the end of the federally declared PHE.
