## **Epinephrine**

Epinephrine auto-injector(s) (0.3 mg) for IM injection as needed for acute allergic reactions including anaphylactic reaction in patients weighing  $\geq$ 30 kg (or 66 lbs.)

Epinephrine auto-injector(s) (0.15 mg) for IM injection as needed for acute allergic reactions including anaphylaxis in patients weighing  $\geq$  15-30 kg (33-66 lbs.)

Epinephrine auto-injector(s)(0.1 mg) for IM injection as needed for acute allergic reactions including anaphylaxis in patients weighing  $\leq$ 15 kg (33 lbs.)

\_\_\_\_\_Epinephrine Spray(s) (neffy<sup>®</sup>) 1mg/0.1 ml) for intranasal (IN) administration as needed for anaphylactic reaction in patients weighing 15 kg to less than 30 kg (33 to 66 lbs.)
