_____ Epinephrine auto-injector(s) (0.15 mg) for IM injection as needed for acute allergic reactions including anaphylaxis in patients weighing ≥ 15 -30 kg (33-66 lbs.)

_____ Epinephrine auto-injector(s) (0.1 mg) for IM injection as needed for acute allergic reactions including anaphylaxis in patients weighing ≤ 15 kg (33 lbs.)

_____ Epinephrine Spray(s) (neffy® 2mg/0.1ml) for Intranasal (IN) administration as needed for acute allergic reactions including anaphylaxis in patients weighing ≥ 30 kg (66 lbs.)

_____ Epinephrine Spray(s) (neffy®) 1mg/0.1 ml) for intranasal (IN) administration as needed for anaphylactic reaction in patients weighing 15 kg to less than 30 kg (33 to 66 lbs.)
