Noble-Bates Young was born and raised in Natchez, MS. She attended Louisiana State University, where she earned a Bachelor's in Sport Administration and a Master's in Public Administration.

Most recently, she served in the district office for Louisiana State Senator Patrick McMath, handling constituent relations and legislative affairs. Over the years, she has worked with the National Alliance on Mental Illness – Southeast Louisiana to manage the Tiny Homes development, assisted Louisiana Economic Development with the Louisiana NOW Pavilion during the Super Bowl, worked at Coquille Parks and Recreation in Covington and Chappapeela Sports Park in Hammond, and most importantly – championed the development and construction of the Miracle League Northshore. In the wake of Hurricane Laura, she founded her nonprofit, Louisiana Coastal Relief and Recovery, which does hurricane relief work across the state.

Noble-Bates has served on the Boards of the St. Tammany Chamber of Commerce, Northshore Young Professionals, and the Leadership St. Tammany Alumni Foundation, as well as Executive Director of the Northshore Business Council. Additionally, she was a member of the Leadership St. Tammany Class of 2019 and the New Orleans Regional Leadership Institute Class of 2023.
