<u>What is changing? / Change Description:</u>	We limit reimbursement of charges for HCPCS code J1439 to no more than 99 units if submitted with drug wastage modifier JW.
<u>Why is Humana making this change? / Change Reason:</u>	<p><u>According to the FDA-approved package insert/prescribing information, ferric carboxymaltose is supplied in a 100 mg single-use vial. It is inappropriate for a healthcare provider to bill drug wastage that equals or exceeds the size of the vial.</u></p> <p><u>Note: At the time of publication of this notice, we do not cover HCPCS code J1439 for Humana's Louisiana Medicaid products.
