Invasive Coronary Angiography and Percutaneous Coronary Intervention

The MCO shall cover elective invasive coronary angiography (ICA) and percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) as treatment for cardiovascular conditions under specific circumstances. ICA for non-acute, stable coronary artery disease is not considered medically necessary, including for patients with stable angina who are not interested in revascularization or who are not candidates for PCI or coronary artery bypass graft surgery.

This policy only applies to enrollees age 18 and older and does not apply to the following enrollees:

- ❖ Enrollees under the age of 18;
- ❖ Pregnant enrollees;
- ❖ Cardiac transplant enrollees;
- ❖ Solid organ transplant candidates; and
- ❖ Survivors of sudden cardiac arrest.
