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CHAPTER 10: MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION

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NEMT OVERVIEW

Non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) is transportation provided to Medicaid beneficiaries to and/or from a Medicaid covered service when no other means of transportation are available. NEMT does not include transportation provided on an emergency basis, such as trips to emergency departments in life_-threatening situations.

This section is applicable to non-ambulance, NEMT only. <u>Services shall be provided in accordance with the Louisiana Administrative Code (LAC)</u>, <u>Title 50</u>, <u>Part XXVII</u>, <u>Chapter 5</u>. <u>NEMT shall not include any non-emergency ambulance transportation or other type of transportation by ambulance <u>See (La. R.S. 40:1257.1)</u>. See the Ambulance section of this <u>mmanual chapter</u> for guidelines specific to non-emergency ambulance transportation (NEAT). <u>NEMT shall not include any non-emergency ambulance transportation or other type of transportation by ambulance. <u>See La. R.S. 40:1257.1</u>. <u>Services shall be provided in accordance with the Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 50, Part XXVII, Chapter 5</u>.</u></u>
