Louisiana Medicaid - Infliximab, 10 mg

What is changing?

We do not reimburse charges for infliximab, 10 mg, for patients younger than 18 if billed with any of the following diagnoses:

- Acute graft-versus-host disease following hematopoietic cell transplantation
- Adult-onset Still disease
- Ankylosing spondylitis (adult)
- Hidradenitis suppurative
- Immune checkpoint inhibitor-related toxicity (colitis)
- Immune checkpoint inhibitor-related toxicity (elevated serum creatinine/acute kidney injury, myalgias or myositis, myocarditis, pneumonitis)
- Immune checkpoint inhibitor-related toxicity (severe inflammatory arthritis)
- Pyoderma gangrenosum associated with inflammatory bowel disease
- Reactive arthropathy
- Rheumatoid arthritis
- SAPHO syndrome
- Sarcoidosis
- Synovitis
