What is changing?

We do not reimburse charges for infliximab, 10 mg, for patients younger than 18 if billed with any of the following diagnoses:

• Acute graft-versus-host disease following hematopoietic cell transplantation

• Adult-onset Still disease

• Ankylosing spondylitis (adult)

• Hidradenitis suppurative

• Immune checkpoint inhibitor-related toxicity (colitis)

• Immune checkpoint inhibitor-related toxicity (elevated serum creatinine/acute kidney injury, myalgias or myositis, myocarditis, pneumonitis)

• Immune checkpoint inhibitor-related toxicity (severe inflammatory arthritis)

• Pyoderma gangrenosum associated with inflammatory bowel disease

• Reactive arthropathy

- SAPHO syndrome

- Synovitis
