

## ACTUARIAL CERTIFICATION

2.10.3.4 For each selected value-added benefit, the proposal should indicate the PMPM actuarial value of benefits assuming an enrollment of 375,000 members, accompanied by a statement from the preparing/consulting actuary who is a member of the American Academy of Actuaries certifying the accuracy of the information.2.9.4.2 The Proposer must submit a signed Proposer's Certification attesting that the Proposer:

I, Tatyana Kotlovskiy, am a member of the American Academy of Actuaries and meet its qualification standards for Statements of Actuarial Opinion. I have examined the actuarial assumptions and actuarial methods used in setting the expanded benefits rates for the entire thirty-six month term of the initial contract period of January 2020 through December 2022.

In my opinion, the value-added benefits rates are actuarially sound, have been developed in accordance with generally accepted actuarial principles and practices and are appropriate for the populations to be covered and the services to be furnished under the contract.

In making my opinion, I have relied upon the historical claim data for eligible enrollees, program eligibility data, internal UnitedHealthcare experience from other markets, as well as reasonable actuarial judgement. Actuarial methods, considerations and analyses used in forming my opinion conform to the appropriate Standards of Practice as delineated by the Actuarial Standards Board, whose standards form the basis of this Statement of Opinion.
