#### DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

### Department of Health Bureau of Health Services Financing

Medicaid Eligibility
Resource Disregards
(LAC 50:III.10705)

The Department of Health, Bureau of Health Services

Financing amends LAC 50:III.10705 in the Medical Assistance

Program as authorized by R.S. 36:254 and pursuant to Title XIX

of the Social Security Act. This Emergency Rule is promulgated

in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative

Procedure Act, R.S. 49:962, and shall be in effect for the

maximum period allowed under the Act or until adoption of the

final Rule, whichever occurs first.

Section 1902(r)(2) of the Social Security Act (SSA) grants states the authority to adopt resource disregards for the purposes of determining eligibility in the Medical Assistance Program (Medicaid). The Department of Health, Bureau of Health Services Financing has determined that it is necessary to disregard unspent funds received as a class member pursuant to a class settlement in the case of Nancy Anderson, et al. v. Bob Dean Jr., et al., 24th Judicial District Court, Parish of Jefferson, No. 820-839 from resources when determining Medicaid eligibility. Under the authority granted by section 1902(r)(2) of the SSA, the department hereby amends the provisions governing financial eligibility in the Medical Assistance

Program in order to disregard unspent funds received by settlement class members in the case of *Nancy Anderson*, et al. v. Bob Dean Jr. et al., 24th Judicial District Court, Parish of Jefferson, No. 820-839 from resources.

This action is being taken to promote the health and well-being of settlement class members by ensuring access to Medicaid services. It is estimated that implementation of this Emergency Rule will have an impact on the Medicaid budget of approximately \$5,081,087 for state fiscal year 2022-2023.

Effective January 1, 2023, the Department of Health, Bureau of Health Services Financing amends the provisions governing financial eligibility in the Medical Assistance Program in order to disregard unspent funds received by settlement class members in the case of Nancy Anderson, et al. v. Bob Dean Jr., et al., 24th Judicial District Court, Parish of Jefferson, No. 820-839 from resources.
