Intermediate Care Facilities for Persons with Intellectual Disabilities Temporary Reimbursement for Private Facilities

The Department of Health, Bureau of Health Services

Financing adopts provisions governing the temporary rates for intermediate care facilities for persons with intellectual disabilities (ICFs/IID) that have a cooperative endeavor agreement with the Office for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities and have a high concentration of people who have intellectual/developmental disabilities, significant behavioral health needs, and high risk behavior resulting in previous interface with the judicial system, and for whom no other private ICFs/IID provider is able to support.

On February 1, 2021, the Department of Health, Bureau of Health Services Financing proposes to promulgate an Emergency Rule to adopt provisions governing transitional reimbursement for private facilities for intermediate care facilities for persons with intellectual disabilities.

Implementation of the provisions of this Rule may be contingent upon the approval of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services

(CMS), if it is determined that submission to CMS for review and approval is required.
