## <u>Inpatient Hospital Services</u> Urban Metropolitan Statistical Area Facility-New Orleans

The Department of Health, Bureau of Health Services

Financing adopts provisions to establish the criteria for an acute care hospital to qualify as an urban metropolitan statistical area (MSA) facility and the reimbursement methodology for the provision of inpatient services. This action is being taken to promote the health and welfare of Medicaid recipients by ensuring continued provider participation in the Medicaid Program.

Effective October 5, 2022, the Department of Health, Bureau of Health Services Financing proposes to promulgate an Emergency Rule to adopt provisions to establish qualifying criteria for an urban MSA facility—New Orleans area and the reimbursement methodology for the provision of inpatient hospital services.

Implementation of the provisions of this Rule may be contingent upon the approval of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), if it is determined that submission to CMS for review and approval is required.
