<u>17-00017 Medicaid Eligibility – Former Foster Care Adolescents</u> Effective date July 20, 2017

The purpose of this SPA is to amend the provisions governing former foster care adolescents in order to terminate the CMS-approved state option to provide Medicaid coverage to youth formerly enrolled in foster care under the responsibility of another state.
