17-0018 - Professional Services Program - Enhanced Federal Medical Assistance Percentage Rate for Preventative Services
Effective date May 15, 2017

The purpose of this SPA is to amend the provisions governing reimbursement for professional services in the Medical Assistance Program in order to establish provisions governing a one percent Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) point increase for the coverage of specific adult vaccines and clinical preventive services provided on a fee-for-service or managed care basis.
