<u>17-0019 - Professional Services Program - Reimbursement Methodology - State Owned or Operated Professional Services Practices</u>

Effective date: May 1, 2017

The purpose of this SPA is to revise the provisions governing the Professional Services Program in order to change the reimbursement methodology for services rendered by physicians and other professional services practitioners employed by, or under contract to provide services in affiliation with a state-owned or operated entity. This rule will reimburse physicians and other professional services practitioners in the amount of billed charges.
