Request for Tribal Comments November 20, 2018

Behavioral Health Services - Substance Use Disorders Services Effective date: March 20, 2019

The purpose of this SPA is to permit managed care organizations (MCOs) to provide opioid use disorder/substance use disorder services to Medicaid recipients in an institution for mental disease (IMD), without regard to the monthly MCO length of stay limit for these residential treatment services in an IMD setting.
