Request for Tribal Comments

**Pharmacy Benefits Management Program – Pharmacy Ingredient Cost Reimbursement**  
**Effective date: May 1, 2019**

The purpose of this SPA is to:

1. Amend the provisions governing reimbursement in the Pharmacy Benefits Management Program in order to change the pharmacy ingredient cost reimbursement methodology from average acquisition cost (AAC) to the national average drug acquisition cost (NADAC); and
2. Increase the professional dispensing fee to \$10.99 per prescription.

**Pharmacy Benefits Management Program – Single Preferred Drug List**  
**Effective date: May 1, 2019**

The purpose of this SPA is to implement a single state-managed preferred drug list (PDL).
