## State Plan Amendments for Submittal to CMS

Request for Tribal Comments October 30, 2019

### <u>Pharmacy Benefits Management Program - Dispense as Written Electronic</u> <u>Prescribing</u>

Effective date: January 20, 2020

The purpose of this SPA is to amend the provisions governing the Pharmacy Benefits Management Program in order to allow notation of the medical necessity of brand drugs using electronic prescriptions, to allow the state to pursue outcomes-based agreements with manufacturers, and to align the provisions with the current Medicaid State Plan.

#### <u>Treatment for Opioid Use Disorder in Opioid Treatment Programs</u> Effective date: January 20, 2020

The purpose of this SPA is to adopt provisions governing medication-assisted opioid use disorder (OUD) treatment in Opioid Treatment Programs, for Medicaid-eligible recipients ages 18 and over, diagnosed with OUD.

# Intermediate Care Facilities for Persons with Intellectual Disabilities Dedicated Program Funding Pool Payments

Effective date: January 20, 2020

The purpose of this SPA is to adopt provisions governing reimbursement to non-state intermediate care facilities for persons with disabilities to allow one-time, lump sum payments from the dedicated program funding pool.
