Transmittal No. 22-0024 Home Health Emergency Provisions

Please refer to the above-proposed State Plan amendment (SPA) submitted under transmittal number (TN) 22-0024 with an effective date of September 20, 2022. The SPA proposed to amend the provisions governing the Home Health program to allow non-physician practitioners to order and review home health services in the event of a federal or state declared emergency or disaster.

CMS reviewed the submittal packet and determined that the proposed change(s) relates to temporary coverage changes that would apply to disasters and emergencies only, rather than permanent coverage in the Medicaid State Plan. In the event of a disaster or public health emergency, the State shall submit disaster relief SPAs to implement such flexibilities.

Based on this information and CMS' recommendation, the Department no longer wishes to pursue the SPA and requests that it be withdrawn from consideration.
