State Plan Amendments for Submittal to CMS

Request for Tribal Comments June 30, 2025

Nursing Facilities Resource Utilization Group (RUG) to Patient Driven Payment Model (PDPM)

Effective date: July 1, 2025

The purpose of this SPA is to amend the standards for payment and reimbursement for nursing facilities in order to implement the patient driven payment model (PDPM) for case-mix classification.

Louisiana Medicaid nursing facility reimbursement rates will be set utilizing the Payment Driven Payment Model (PDPM) resident classification system for the calculation of casemix indices (CMI), and the Resource Utilization Grouper (RUG-III) will no longer be utilized. A blend of five PDPM components will be utilized in the calculation of CMIs. This change will be applied to the nursing facility cost report period case-mix index utilized in rate rebasing procedures, as well as the nursing facility-wide average case-mix index values utilized in the quarterly rate setting process.

Inpatient Hospital Services Sickle Cell Gene Therapy Effective date: July 1, 2025

The purpose of this SPA is to amend provisions governing inpatient hospital services. Gene therapies for sickle cell disease administered during an inpatient stay shall be reimbursed outside of the per diem rate for the inpatient stay. Claims for gene therapies for sickle cell disease shall be reimbursed at actual acquisition cost.
