D. Physical	Hitting, slapping, pinching, choking, kicking, scratching someone	exposing oneself, flirtatious behavior, fondling self or others
E. Exploitation	An individual choosing to not eat or not take their medication, a person with disabilities not taking care of themselves	sudden weight loss, inadequate clothing, lacking necessities like food, utilities, adequate furniture
F. Self-neglect	Yelling or cursing at someone, ridiculing, coercing, harassing, threatening, intimidating someone	unexplained loss of someone's money or property, unusual banking activity, unpaid bills
