COVID-19:

SAFE TRAVEL GUIDANCE

UPDATED: 12/08/2021



The Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommend delaying all travel until persons are <u>fully vaccinated</u>. While vaccination efforts are underway, safe travel is of utmost importance to prevent introduction of variant strains into Louisiana — particularly because travel itself (especially the use of shared spaces in planes, buses, railways or boats) can increase a person's chance of spreading and/or infecting themselves with COVID-19.

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

- All travelers should follow <u>CDC Travel Guidance</u> for <u>Domestic Travel</u> and <u>International Travel</u>, as well as follow state and local guidance including CDC public health recommendations.
- <u>Masks are required</u> for travelers 2 years of age or older and should be worn over the nose and mouth in indoor areas of public transportation (including airplanes) and indoors in US transportation hubs (including airports).
- International air passengers must show a negative COVID-19 viral test result taken no more than 1 day before travel to the United States or proof of recovery within the last 90 days.
- Do not travel if you have been exposed to COVID-19, you are sick, or if you test positive for COVID-19.
- All travelers should self-monitor for <u>symptoms of COVID-19</u>; isolate and get tested if you develop symptoms.

UNVACCINATED TRAVELERS

- Postpone all travel until you are <u>fully vaccinated</u>.
- If you must travel, get tested with a viral test 1 3 days before travel and 3 5 days after travel. If you are returning to the United States, you are required to show a negative COVID-19 test result taken no more than 1 day before travel.
- <u>Masks are required</u> while traveling on any form of public transportation such as planes, buses, trains and boats. Please consider wearing masks in crowded outdoor settings.
- Remember to social distance where possible, and frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer (with at least 60% alcohol).

• After travel, <u>self-quarantine</u> for 7 days even if you test negative by a viral test 3 – 5 days after travel. If you do not get tested with a viral test, you will need to self-quarantine for 10 days.

FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELERS

- <u>Fully vaccinated</u> means it has been two weeks since your final vaccine dose (after 2nd shot for Pfizer and Moderna or after 1st shot for Johnson & Johnson vaccine).
- Fully vaccinated travelers are less likely to get and spread COVID-19.
- <u>Masks are required</u> while traveling on any form of public transportation such as planes, buses, trains and boats.
- You are not required to test before or after domestic travel, but before boarding a flight to the United States, you are required to show a negative COVID-19 test result taken no more than 1 day before travel.
- You are not required to quarantine, but you should self-monitor for symptoms related to COVID-19 during or after travel.
- In the unlikely event you develop symptoms of COVID-19 during or after travel, <u>isolate</u> yourself and get tested.
