### **Around the World**



In 2018, an estimated **37.9 million** people were living with HIV.



Since the start of the epidemic, an estimated **32.0 million** people have **died from an AIDS-related illness**.



An estimated **1.7 million** people were **diagnosed with HIV** in 2018, a **40% decrease** since diagnoses peaked in 1997.

## **HIV & AIDS in the United States**

- There are over 1.1 million Americans living with HIV.
- In 2017, nearly 40,000 people were diagnosed with HIV.
- In 2017, over 17,000 people were diagnosed with AIDS.

# HIV and AIDS in Louisiana



In 2018, there were **21,770 people living with HIV** in Louisiana.

Over half of people living with HIV had a prior AIDS diagnosis.

It is estimated that **1 in 5** people living with HIV in Louisiana


are undiagnosed and do not know their HIV status.





In 2018 there were **983 new HIV diagnoses in Louisiana.** The lowest number of new diagnoses since the peak of the epidemic in 1992.

#### Among persons living with HIV in 2018...






71% were male
