


### CHLAMYDIA—REGION 5

- In 2016, 1,376 persons were diagnosed with chlamydia for a rate of 456.4 per 100,000.
- In 2017, 1,622 persons were diagnosed with chlamydia for a rate of 534.6 per 100,000.
- In 2018, **1,839** persons were diagnosed with chlamydia for a rate of **603.9** per 100,000, a 12% rate increase from 2017
- In 2018, Region 5 had the lowest number of chlamydia diagnoses and the 8th highest diagnosis rate in Louisiana.



### **CHLAMYDIA BY SEX AT BIRTH**

• In 2016, **75**% of chlamydia diagnoses were among females. This proportion increased to **77**% in 2017 and decreased to **75**% in 2018. In 2018, **25**% of chlamydia diagnoses in Region 5 were among males.

## CHLAMYDIA BY RACE/ETHNICITY

Blacks account for the majority of chlamydia diagnoses each year in Region 5. Only 22% of Region 5 is black.

- In 2016, 56% of chlamydia diagnoses were among blacks, decreasing to 55% in 2017 and 2018.
- In 2016, 40% of chlamydia diagnoses were among whites, increasing to 41% in 2017 and 2018.
- From 2016 to 2018, **3**% of chlamydia diagnoses were among Hispanic/Latinx.

### **CHLAMYDIA BY AGE AT DIAGNOSIS**

The majority of Region 5 chlamydia diagnoses are in persons under the age of 25.

- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 24 and under was 75% 2016, 76% in 2017, and 71% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 25-34 years was 20% in 2016, 19% in 2017, and 24% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 35 and older was 5% from 2016 to 2018.

### **CHLAMYDIA BY PARISH**

• From 2016 to 2018, the greatest proportion of chlamydia diagnoses were in Calcasieu Parish. In 2016, Jefferson Davis Parish had the highest chlamydia diagnosis rate. In 2017 and 2018, Calcasieu Parish had the highest chlamydia diagnosis rate.



### **GONORRHEA—REGION 5**

- In 2016, 428 persons were diagnosed with gonorrhea for a rate of 142.0 per 100,000.
- In 2017, 513 persons were diagnosed with gonorrhea for a rate of 169.1 per 100,000.
- In 2018, **564** persons were diagnosed with gonorrhea for a rate of **185.2** per 100,000, a 9% rate increase from 2017.
- In 2018, Region 5 had the lowest number of gonorrhea diagnoses and the 8th highest diagnosis rate in Louisiana.



### **GONORRHEA BY SEX AT BIRTH**

• In 2016, **55**% of gonorrhea diagnoses were among females. This proportion increased to **62**% in 2017 and decreased to **58**% in 2018. In 2018, **42**% of gonorrhea diagnoses in Region 5 were among males.

### **GONORRHEA BY RACE/ETHNICITY**

Blacks account for the majority of gonorrhea diagnoses each year in Region 5. Only 22% of Region 5 is black.

- In 2016, 66% of gonorrhea diagnoses were among blacks, decreasing to 65% in 2017, and to 59% in 2018.
- In 2016 and 2017, 33% of gonorrhea diagnoses were among whites, increasing to 36% in 2018.
- In 2016, 1% of gonorrhea diagnoses were among Hispanic/Latinx, 2% in 2017 and 2018.

### **GONORRHEA BY AGE AT DIAGNOSIS**

The majority of gonorrhea diagnoses in Region 5 are in persons under the age of 25.

- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 24 and under was 64% in 2016, 67% in 2017, and 57% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 25-34 years was 27% in 2016 and 2017, increasing to 32% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 35 and older was 9% 2016, 6% in 2017, and 11% in 2018.

### **GONORRHEA BY PARISH**


• From 2016 to 2018, the greatest proportion of gonorrhea diagnoses and the highest diagnoses rates were in Calcasieu Parish.

### PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS—REGION 5

- In 2016, 21 persons were diagnosed with P&S syphilis for a rate of 7.0 per 100,000.
- In 2017, 26 persons were diagnosed with P&S syphilis for a rate of 8.6 per 100,000.
- In 2018, 8 persons were diagnosed with P&S syphilis for a rate of 2.6 per 100,000, a 70% rate decrease from 2017
- In 2018, Region 5 had the lowest number of P&S syphilis diagnoses and the lowest diagnosis rate in Louisiana.



### PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS BY SEX AT BIRTH

• In 2016, **81**% of P&S syphilis diagnoses were among males. This proportion decreased to **62**% in 2017 and to **50**% in 2018. In 2018, **50**% of P&S syphilis diagnoses in Region 5 were among females.

## PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS BY RACE/ETHNICITY

Blacks account for at least half of P&S syphilis diagnoses in Region 5. Only 22% of Region 5 is black.

- In 2016, 57% of P&S syphilis diagnoses were among blacks, 62% in 2017, and 75% in 2018.
- In 2016, 43% of P&S syphilis diagnoses were among whites, 38% in 2017, and 25% in 2018.

### PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS BY AGE AT DIAGNOSIS

More than half of P&S syphilis diagnoses in Region 5 are among persons age 25 and older.

- The proportion of diagnoses among persons under the age of 25 was **38**% in 2016, **27**% in 2017, and **13**% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 25-34 years was 33% in 2016, 50% in 2017, and 25% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 35 and older was 29% in 2016, 23% in 2017, and 63% in 2018.

### PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS BY PARISH


• From 2016 to 2018, Calcasieu Parish had the greatest proportion of P&S syphilis diagnoses and the highest diagnosis rate in Region 5.

### **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES—REGION 5**

- In 2016, **38** persons were diagnosed with HIV for a rate of **12.6** per 100,000.
- In 2017, **55** persons were diagnosed with HIV for a rate of **18.2** per 100,000.
- In 2018, 38 persons were diagnosed with HIV for a rate of 12.5 per 100,000, a 31% rate decrease from 2017.
- In 2018, Region 5 had the lowest number of new HIV diagnoses and the 7th highest HIV diagnosis rate in Louisiana.



### **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES BY SEX AT BIRTH**

• In 2016, **89**% of new HIV diagnoses were among males. This proportion decreased to **78**% in 2017 and **74**% in 2018. In 2018, **26**% of all new HIV diagnoses in Region 5 were among females.

### **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES BY RACE/ETHNICITY**

Blacks account for over half of the new HIV diagnoses each year in Region 5. Only 22% of Region 5 is black.

- In 2016, **61%** of new HIV diagnoses were among blacks, **51%** in 2017, and **63%** in 2018.
- In 2016, 34% of new HIV diagnoses were among whites, 38% in 2017, and 34% in 2018.
- In 2016, 5% of new HIV diagnoses were among Hispanic/Latinx, 5% in 2017, and 3% in 2018.

### **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES BY AGE AT DIAGNOSIS**

In 2018, the majority of new HIV diagnoses in Region 5 were among persons 15-34 years old.

- The proportion of diagnoses among persons under the age of 25 was 32% in 2016, 29% in 2017, 21% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 25-34 years was 11% in 2016, 35% in 2017, 34% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 35-44 years was 26% in 2016, 15% in 2017, 21% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 45 and older was 32% in 2016, 22% in 2017, 24% in 2018.

### **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES BY PARISH**

• From 2016 to 2018, the greatest proportion of new HIV diagnoses and the highest rate of HIV diagnosis were in Calcasieu Parish.

In 2018, Louisiana ranked 3rd in the nation for Congenital Syphilis rates, 2nd for Chlamydia rates, 7th for Primary and Secondary Syphilis rates, and 5th for Gonorrhea rates. In 2017, Louisiana ranked 4th for HIV rates and 3rd for AIDS rates in the US.
