


# **CHLAMYDIA—REGION 6**

- In 2016, 2,066 persons were diagnosed with chlamydia for a rate of 675.7 per 100,000.
- In 2017, 2,148 persons were diagnosed with chlamydia for a rate of 705.0 per 100,000.
- In 2018, 2,240 persons were diagnosed with chlamydia for a rate of 745.2 per 100,000, a 6% rate increase from 2017.
- In 2018, Region 6 had the 8th highest number of chlamydia diagnoses and the 6th highest diagnosis rate in Louisiana.



### **CHLAMYDIA BY SEX AT BIRTH**

• In 2016, **74**% of chlamydia diagnoses were among females. This proportion decreased to **71**% in 2017 and **70**% in 2018. In 2018, **30**% of chlamydia diagnoses in Region 6 were among males.

# **CHLAMYDIA BY RACE/ETHNICITY**

Blacks account for the majority of chlamydia diagnoses each year in Region 6. Only 27% of Region 6 is black.

- In 2016 and 2017, 62% of chlamydia diagnoses were among blacks, increasing to 64% in 2018.
- In 2016, 35% of chlamydia diagnoses were among whites, 34% in 2017, and 33% in 2018.
- From 2016 to 2018, **3%** of chlamydia diagnoses were among Hispanic/Latinx.

#### **CHLAMYDIA BY AGE AT DIAGNOSIS**

The majority of Region 6 chlamydia diagnoses are in persons under the age of 25.

- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 24 and under was 74% in 2016, 75% in 2017, and 73% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 25-34 years was 22% in 2016, 21% in 2017, and 22% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 35 and older was 4% in 2016 and 5% in 2017 and 2018.

# **CHLAMYDIA BY PARISH**


• From 2016 to 2018, the greatest proportion of chlamydia diagnoses was in Rapides Parish. In 2016 and 2017, Rapides Parish had the highest chlamydia diagnosis rate. In 2018, Avoyelles Parish had the highest chlamydia diagnosis rate. Chlamydia diagnoses in Avoyelles Parish have increased by 46% from 2016 to 2018.

## **GONORRHEA—REGION 6**

- In 2016, 660 persons were diagnosed with gonorrhea for a rate of 215.9 per 100,000.
- In 2017, 739 persons were diagnosed with gonorrhea for a rate of 242.6 per 100,000.
- In 2018, 865 persons were diagnosed with gonorrhea for a rate of 287.8 per 100,000, a 19% rate increase from 2017.
- In 2018, Region 6 had the 7th highest number of gonorrhea diagnoses and the 4th highest diagnosis rate in Louisiana.



#### **GONORRHEA BY SEX AT BIRTH**

• In 2016, **53**% of gonorrhea diagnoses were among females. This proportion increased to **55**% in 2017 and decreased to **50**% in 2018. In 2018, **50**% of gonorrhea diagnoses in Region 6 were among males.

## **GONORRHEA BY RACE/ETHNICITY**

Blacks account for the majority of gonorrhea diagnoses each year in Region 6. Only 27% of Region 6 is black.

- In 2016, 71% of gonorrhea diagnoses were among blacks, decreasing to 68% in 2017, and 64% in 2018.
- In 2016, 27% of gonorrhea diagnoses were among whites, increasing to 30% in 2017, and 34% in 2018.
- From 2016 to 2018, 1% of gonorrhea diagnoses were among Hispanic/Latinx.

#### **GONORRHEA BY AGE AT DIAGNOSIS**

The majority of gonorrhea diagnoses in Region 6 are in persons under the age of 25.

- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 24 and under decreased from 65% in 2016 to 60% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 25-34 years increased from 24% in 2016 to 28% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 35 and older increased from 10% in 2016 to 12% in 2018.

#### **GONORRHEA BY PARISH**


From 2016 to 2018, the greatest proportion of gonorrhea diagnoses was in Rapides Parish. In 2016 and 2018,
Rapides Parish had the highest rate of gonorrhea diagnoses. In 2017, Avoyelles Parish had the highest gonorrhea rate.

### PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS—REGION 6

- In 2016, 30 persons were diagnosed with P&S syphilis for a rate of 9.8 per 100,000.
- In 2017, **33** persons were diagnosed with P&S syphilis for a rate of **10.8** per 100,000.
- In 2018, 92 persons were diagnosed with P&S syphilis for a rate of 30.6 per 100,000, a 183% rate increase from 2017.
- In 2018, Region 6 had the 3rd highest number of P&S syphilis diagnoses and the highest diagnosis rate in Louisiana.



#### PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS BY SEX AT BIRTH

• In 2016, **73**% of P&S syphilis diagnoses were among males. This proportion decreased to **64**% in 2017 and increased to **66**% in 2018. In 2018, **34**% of P&S syphilis diagnoses in Region 6 were among females.

# PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS BY RACE/ETHNICITY

Blacks account for the majority of P&S syphilis diagnoses in Region 6. 27% of Region 6 is black.

- In 2016, 73% of P&S syphilis diagnoses were among blacks, 52% in 2017, and 54% in 2018.
- In 2016, 23% of P&S syphilis diagnoses were among whites, 48% in 2017, and 46% in 2018.
- In 2016, 3% of P&S syphilis diagnoses were among Hispanic/Latinx. There were zero diagnoses in 2017 and 2018.

# **PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS BY AGE AT DIAGNOSIS**

The age of persons newly diagnosed with P&S syphilis is increasing in Region 6.

- The proportion of diagnoses among persons under the age of 25 was **50%** in 2016, **39%** in 2017, and **20%** in 2018
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 25-34 years was 33% in 2016, 36% in 2017, and 59% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 35 and older was 17% in 2016, 24% in 2017, and 22% in 2018.

## **PRIMARY & SECONDARY SYPHILIS BY PARISH**


• From 2016 to 2018, Rapides Parish had the greatest proportion of P&S syphilis diagnoses and the highest diagnosis rate. The number of diagnoses in Rapides Parish has tripled in three years.

### **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES—REGION 6**

- In 2016, **59** persons were diagnosed with HIV for a rate of **19.3** per 100,000.
- In 2017, **45** persons were diagnosed with HIV for a rate of **14.7** per 100,000.
- In 2018, **73** persons were diagnosed with HIV for a rate of **24.3** per 100,000, a 65% rate increase from 2017.
- In 2018, Region 6 had the 5th highest number of new HIV diagnoses and the 3rd highest HIV diagnosis rate in Louisiana.



#### **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES BY SEX AT BIRTH**

• In 2016, **75**% of new HIV diagnoses were among males. This proportion decreased to **71**% in 2017 and **70**% in 2018. In 2018, **30**% of all new HIV diagnoses in Region 6 were among females.

## **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES BY RACE/ETHNICITY**

Blacks account for the majority of new HIV diagnoses each year in Region 6. Only 27% of Region 6 is black.

- In 2016, **61%** of new HIV diagnoses were among blacks, **47%** in 2017, and **53%** in 2018.
- In 2016, 31% of new HIV diagnoses were among whites, 40% in 2017, and 37% in 2018.
- In 2016, 5% of HIV diagnoses were among Hispanic/Latinx, 13% in 2017, and 8% in 2018.

#### **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES BY AGE AT DIAGNOSIS**

In 2018, the majority of new HIV diagnoses in Region 6 were among persons 25-34 years-old.

- The proportion of diagnoses among persons under the age of 25 was 17% in 2016; 13% in 2017; 12% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 25-34 years was 31% in 2016; 22% in 2017; 36% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 35-44 years old was 29% in 2016; 31% in 2017; 18% in 2018.
- The proportion of diagnoses among persons 45 and older was 24% in 2016; 33% in 2017; 34% in 2018.

#### **NEW HIV DIAGNOSES BY PARISH**

• From 2016 to 2018, the greatest proportion of new HIV diagnoses was in Rapides Parish. In 2018, the highest rate of new HIV diagnoses was in LaSalle Parish.

In 2018, Louisiana ranked 3rd in the nation for Congenital Syphilis rates, 2nd for Chlamydia rates, 7th for Primary and Secondary Syphilis rates, and 5th for Gonorrhea rates. In 2017, Louisiana ranked 4th for HIV rates and 3rd for AIDS rates in the US.
