### **Beginning Balance Receipt**



The **Beginning Balance Receipt** shows all WIC Approved Food Items available to the Particpant prior to the WIC Transaction. This receipt is given to Particpants after they insert their eWIC Card and enter the PIN.

In the example to the left, prior to the WIC Transaction, the beginning benefit balance includes (in part):

- \$11.14 in fruits and vegetables
- 1.75 containers of dried or canned beans/lentils/peas
- 2 pounds of whole grains

## **Utilization Receipt**



The **Utilization Receipt** shows which WIC Approved Food Items will be deducted from the Particpant's WIC Benefits balance after the WIC Transaction. This receipt is given to the Particpant after all items have been scanned. Ask the Participant to review the Utilization Receipt and confirm that they agree to the WIC Transaction before they "Accept" or "Update" their WIC Benefits on the PIN pad or terminal.

In the example to the left the WIC items to be deducted from the benefits balance are:

- \$0.79 in fruits and vegetables (corn)
- 0.25 containers of dried or canned beans/lentils/peas (blackeye peas)
- 1 pound of whole grains (brown rice)

The **Ending Balance Receipt** shows all remaining WIC Approved Food Items available to the Participant after the WIC Transaction. This receipt is given to the Participant after they "Accept" or "Update" their WIC Benefits on the PIN pad or terminal.

In the example to the left, after the WIC Transaction is completed, the ending benefits balance includes:

- \$10.35 in fruits and vegetables
- 1.5 containers of dried or canned beans/lentils/peas
- 1 pound of whole grains

The **Purchase Receipt** shows all items, both WIC and non-WIC, purchased during the transaction, the price the store charged for each item, and the total amount paid by the Particpant. This receipt is given to the Particpant after all payments have been processed.

In the example to the left, the price the store charged for each WIC item is:

- \$0.79 for corn
- \$0.79 for blackeye peas
- \$.079 for brown rice

and the payments provided by the Particpant are:

- \$2.37 via eWIC
- \$4.17 via Debit Card (for non-WIC item)
